

# Do you support the closure of King Street to vehicles on Saturdays?

Some traders in Southwell recently voiced their support for the closure of King Street (the one-way section from One Stop westwards to Queen Street) to all but emergency vehicles on Saturdays, to help create a better environment in the town centre for families and shoppers.
